Section 22 Railways Act 1993: Amendments to the Station Access Conditions for Sunderland station where Northern Trains Limited is the Station Facility Owner

I enclose notice of approval for the amendments made to the Station Access Conditions for Sunderland station, where Northern Trains Limited is the Station Facility Owner. The amendments were contained in the amending document submitted to the Office of Rail and Road (ORR), under section 22 of the Railways Act 1993 (the Act) on 4 January 2024.

In approving the amendments we have taken into account our duties under section 4 of the Railways Act 1993 (the Act).

A copy of the amending document will be placed on the ORR public register in accordance with section 72 of the Act. No exclusions will be made prior to it being placed on the public register, unless a request for redaction is made to us. Service Facility Description

We draw your attention to Regulation 13(3) of <u>The Railways (Access, Management and Licensing of Railway Undertakings)</u> Regulations 2016, which requires a service facility provider (e.g. the operator of a station) to provide the manager of the infrastructure to which its facility is connected with such information as necessary to include in its Network Statement, and to keep it updated.

Commission Implementing Regulation (EU) 2017/2177 of 22 November 2017 on access to service facilities and rail-related services (retained in domestic law, subject to some amendments, by SI 2019/1310) further specifies that operators of service facilities must publish a Service Facility Description (SFD) for the service facilities

and services for which they are responsible. The SFD should include the information set out in Article 4(2) of the Implementing Regulation, and must be made publicly available, free of charge, in one of the following ways:

- (a) by publishing it on the service facility operator's web portal, or on a common web portal, and providing the infrastructure manager of the network with a link to be included in the infrastructure manager's Network Statement; or
- (b) by providing the infrastructure manager with the relevant, and ready-to-bepublished information, to be included in the Network Statement.

Infrastructure managers must facilitate the collection of this information and make it available. A common template format for service facility information has been developed by RailNet Europe available at https://rne.eu/downloads/. Service facility operators may also wish to consider utilising the Rail Facilities Portal https://railfacilitiesportal.eu/.

You may find it helpful to read our <u>guidance on service facilities</u>, and in particular chapter 4. Please note that is a legal requirement that a service facility operator must establish a SFD. It is their responsibility to ensure that they are compliant with those legal requirements.

SPECIFIC APPROVAL FOR STATIONS 2017

SUNDERLAND STATION (ORR REF: SSA/15/220/95/01)

Made under the National Station Access Conditions 2013 (England & Wales) and Annexes applicable to the Station(s).

1.0 PROPOSALS

The geographical scope of the change proposal is limited to Sunderland Station south entrance building, which will be demolished and rebuilt, and the interface at platform level with the south entrance building where it is proposed to install new fire protection lobby doors at the foot of the access stairs and escalator. No other permanent changes are proposed to the north entrance, platform level, or any other part of the station.

During implementation of the proposal, the entire south entrance building and its facilities will be unavailable to all station users and staff, except for an encased escape route to be maintained through the construction site to be used in emergencies. During this period all access to/from platform level will be via the station's north entrance only. Station facilities that can be temporarily relocated from the south entrance into the north entrance (including Ticket Vending Machines, Ticket Validators, and information/advertising displays) will be done so in cooperation with Station Operators

The proposed construction methodology has been developed so that all works interfacing with the railway will be delivered in non-disruptive overnight Rules of the Route Possessions and implementation of the proposal will not have any impact on train operations through Sunderland Station

2.0 AMENDMENTS REQUIRED

The implementation of the proposals would necessitate changes to the agreements affecting the station as follows:
